

2026 Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

What is the Point-In-Time Count?

The PIT Count is a critical survey effort that aims to capture a snapshot of homelessness in Pinal County to raise awareness and provide essentials to individuals. The Department of Housing Development (HUD) requires that all Continuums of Care (CoC) conduct an annual count of people experiencing homelessness on a single night.

- To Raise Community Awareness
- To advocate for local and Federal Funding
- To understand characteristics and trend of homelessness
- To engage our communities in ending homelessness
