The Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH) is pleased to announce this State Housing Trust Funds Notice of Funding Availability requesting proposals from eligible non-profit organizations, experienced for-profit companies, and municipal government entities proposing the construction, renovation, expansion, or operations of emergency shelter facilities; the construction, renovation, expansion or operations of transitional housing facilities; or the construction or renovation of other types of shelter or housing serving individuals who have been determined to be Seriously Mentally Ill (SMI), or chronically resistant to treatment. All projects must serve populations with an Area Median Income (AMI) of 80% or lower.

The available resources under this NOFA include \$9 million in State Housing Trust Funds.
