Dear Community Partner,

On December 21, 2025, Faithful Footsteps Street Outreach, in partnership with A Servant's Hands, will host the first-ever National Day of Remembrance for the Homeless in Casa Grande, Arizona.

This day carries two purposes: to honor the memory of those in our community who lost their lives while experiencing homelessness, and to provide direct resources, services, and hope to those still living on our streets today. We want people to leave that day with more than they came with — including, for some, a path to housing.

We are reaching out to you because Casa Grande's most vulnerable residents need their community to show up for them. This event will not happen without local support, and we believe you share our commitment to the people we serve.

OUR MISSION

"Born from a belief that every life carries sacred worth, the National Day of Remembrance for the Homeless gathers our community each December 21st to do three things: to honor the memory of those who died without a home, to bring direct resources and services to those still living without one, and to press our community toward the day when no one in Casa Grande sleeps without shelter. We remember. We serve. We act."

Remember the lost. Serve the living. House the homeless.

About the Event

Date: December 21, 2026

Time: 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM (4 hours during business day timing)

Location: Casa Grande, Arizona (venue TBD)

Anticipated Attendance: 100–300 community members, homeless individuals, and service providers

The event will include:

- A solemn remembrance ceremony with a reading of names of those lost
- A resource fair with tables from housing providers, benefits enrollment, health services, and more
- Distribution of food, water, hygiene supplies, and seasonal necessities (socks, gloves, hats)
- Direct connections between guests and housing providers who may be able to house someone that day

- Mental health, substance use, and Veterans' resources

Sponsorship Opportunities

- Tables, chairs, canopies / tents
- Gift cards (gas, grocery, pharmacy) for direct distribution
- Transportation assistance for guests
